What did you just do...?

Yes, what did you do? You answered our call and gave us money to buy Bibles for Kids in Nigeria. You just started a revolution – a Revival! You have empowered a group of kids to march against the gates of hell. That's what you did - Praise the Lord!

You may not know the full impact of your response when you acted in obedience to the Lord and gave out of the little income that God has provided for you (trust me, we know things are tough these days for many families). Last week, we took delivery of 200 English Bibles (RSV), and 25 Yoruba Bibles – all purchased at a discounted rate from the Bible Society of Nigeria.

We captured the excitement at the Bible Club meeting last week as the kids – each with their own personal Bible – competed eagerly to be first to open and read a Bible passage that their teacher called out (see picture). So...you may wonder how kids who never owned any Bibles were able to quickly flip through Bible pages to a verse, moments after receiving their new Bibles. The answer is simple - they have memorized ALL the books of the Bible, and many Bible verses from weeks of coming to the Bible club meetings. It makes a real difference now that they have their own Bibles.

You have sown the seed with your donation, now we wait for the harvest. Each kid now has an opportunity to underline and mark passages as they wish in their Bibles - during personal studies at home.



As more new kids show up for Bible Club meetings, we want to have enough Bible supplies to give out. Also, we have plans to start a library collection of Christian books (for circulation) that kids can check out in addition to Bibles. This would encourage and help the kids grow in their Christian life. We are serious in discipling these kids to be a new generation that would live for God and impact their communities in spreading the Gospel of Christ. Please help us in achieving this goal with your continued prayers and donations.

...and God answered before she prayed ...

We cannot resist sharing the testimony of a young lady who is a new convert in one of our village ministries. Miriam (not her real name) came from a polygamous Muslim family who reside in one of the villages that we operate. Growing up, Miriam learned hairdressing, helping to braid hair for women in her village. She heard the Gospel preached in her village and she decided to follow Jesus. She left home for a nearby town because her family would not tolerate her newfound faith. She made enough income from hairdressing to support herself through High School. She was the only one in her large family to complete High School and gain admission to Junior College. However, the cost of tuition was too much for her small income, but the College allowed her to continue with classes while still owing tuition. About two weeks ago, she asked our village evangelistic team to pray for her because exams were about to start this week and she would not be allowed to sit for the exams without paying her school fees. She needed to pay by Saturday March 7 in order to sit for exams starting Monday March 9. This lady, who is very young in the lord, had so much faith that God would supply her needs by the deadline of Saturday morning that the school had set. She was not afraid to proclaim to everyone that God will provide her school fees by the morning of Saturday, March 7.

On our side (Ife Global Outreach) we had been preoccupied (throughout February and early March) with getting Bibles and planning for Medical Outreach programs. I didn't have time to read new reports that came in from the village ministry team. I didn't know anything about Miriam. By evening on Thursday March 5, I felt the urge to read the report that our partner evangelist had written over 2 weeks earlier including the story of Miriam. God had also told a family to support us with donations twice in the last week of February - so we didn't have an excuse not to help Miriam with immediate funds at very short notice. So, Miriam's prayers were answered. She received her full school fees on Saturday morning as she had told everyone by faith that God would provide her school fees by the deadline set by her school.

As I write this newsletter, I reflected on what could have happened if I hadn't read the report on Thursday night and didn't know about Miriam or her needs. I also reflected on the family that gave donations which came at the right time. God made me realize He orchestrated everything – knowing that a young Christian lady is going to put all her faith in God to supply her needs – not really knowing how or when or if it would happen. God reminded me of what Jesus said in Matt 6: 8 – God knows what we need before we ask. So, I want to thank everyone for your prayers and for your obedience to the Holy Spirit in giving generously to this ministry. It matters.
